CVAB RECOVERY SUPPORT SPECIALIST (RSS)

The RSS provides peer support services, serves as an advocate, and provides information and support for peers in a variety of settings. The RSS performs a wide range of tasks to support peers in living their own lives and directing their own recovery, healing and wellness process. The RSS will model recovery, healing and wellness competencies. REACH Too staff will continually strive to educate themselves about peer recovery support and will always promote the program positively in the community by modeling prosocial attitudes and behaviors.

QUALIFICATIONS

Preferred qualifications for the CVAB Recovery Support Specialist:

1. Must be a positive, self-motivated individual who has demonstrated ability to work independently and well with others as a member of various teams
2. Strong interpersonal skills and ability to deal effectively with cultural diversity of individuals at all organizational levels
3. Innovative, flexible, and willingness to work with constantly changing environment and priorities without losing enthusiasm for the organizational mission
4. Good written and verbal communication skills are required
5. A computer aptitude and working knowledge of Microsoft Office Suite
6. Good judgment with the ability to make timely and sound decisions
7. Demonstrates attention to detail
8. Must be able to speak, read, write and understand English
9. Active in personal recovery and experience with Child Protective Services and Clark County Family Treatment Court
10. Have no recent felony convictions or recent drug usage history, and must not be on active probation or supervision in any jurisdiction
11. Completion of Connecticut Community for Addiction Recovery (CCAR) Recovery Coach training prior to or within six months of start date
12. Ability to meet minimal criminal background check clearance
13. Have a Valid Driver's License and full coverage insurance. A personal vehicle is required for this position
