What is a CVAB?

The Opportunity

CVAB is collaborating with Sea Mar Health Clinic in Vancouver, WA to provide peer support with people in the Hep C Clinic. As a Peer Support Coordinator, you will work alongside the medical clinic staff and in the community to support individuals in Hep C treatment and completing the Test for Cure. You will also be able to enlist people completing the treatment to support others in achieving results.



The Responsibilities

No two days are alike so your responsibilities will vary day to day. Specifically, your responsibilities will include offering one-on-one support for patients of the SeaMar Hep C Clinic by developing a support plan, managing medications, attending appointments and overcoming other barriers to receiving treatment. As the program grows the Hep C Peer Support Coordinator will be responsible for recruiting and training volunteers to continue and expand services to patients. Additionally, you will successfully complete documentation as necessary. All of this and more will be in alignment with CVAB's Core Values.

The Qualifications

We are looking for people that are positive, self-motivated, who have demonstrated the ability to work independently and well with others. Most importantly, you must be knowledgeable about lived experience with Hepatitis C and its treatment, and have a willingness to share your experience. (specifics are listed on CVAB website—see below). This position will require the ability to travel throughout Clark County, and work evenings or weekends as needed to perform your duties.
