The Opportunity

Pier 360 is seeking a full-time Peer Bridger. The Peer Bridger is a WA Certified Peer Counselor who supports individuals with the transition from Western State Hospital or other inpatient facilities to the Southwest Washington community. All Pier 360 services employ people living in mental health and/or substance use recovery. The Peer Support staff performs a wide range of tasks to support people living and directing their own recovery, healing, and wellness process.



The Responsibilities

Provide quality peer support services in alignment with our Core Values and Core Competencies for Peer Workers in Behavioral Health Services (SAMHSA). Please refer to the complete position description for more details (available online). Like many people, many peers in recovery have experienced the uncertainty and insecurity of change. The Peer Bridger provides supportive assistance and empowers individuals who are being discharged from the structured environment of hospitalization. Additional responsibilities include working alongside team members, facilitating groups, classes, and activities, and connecting peers to community resources.

The Qualifications

We are looking for people who are positive, take initiative, have demonstrated the ability to work independently and well with others, are in recovery, and are great at being with others seeking something better or different in life. For this role, we require lived experience with therapeutic courts and incarceration. The successful applicant will need to meet Clark County Jail clearance requirements.
